**NCA abused powers over sim card blockage – Minority:** The Minority in Parliament led by its leader, Haruna Iddrisu has accused the National Communications Authority (NCA) of exceeding their mandates of the law by blocking Ghanaians of their sim cards. According to them, today, digitalization and ICT are directly tied to key fundamental rights including the right to privacy and communication as no person should be subjected to interference with the privacy of his communication (Article 18 supra). SIM card owners in Ghana who failed to re-register their cards started facing punitive actions on Monday, September 5, 2022, ahead of the September 30 deadline. (Norvanreports)



**SEC, EOCO flag seventeen (17) unregulated entities:** The Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), has warned the general public against investing in 17 unregulated entities noting that dealings of any sort with these institutions will be at their own risk. The caution was conveyed in a joint statement issued by the Commission and the Economic and Organized Crime Office (EOCO) following a collaborative investigation into the activities of some entities, most of which operate primarily through online channels. Among the entities include Snap Finance, Faucet Wealth Investment, Cedi Network Ghana, Bitcash Investment, and Solmax Group. (Business & Financial Times)

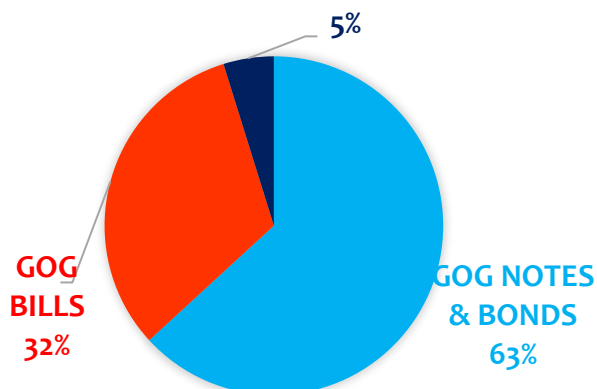

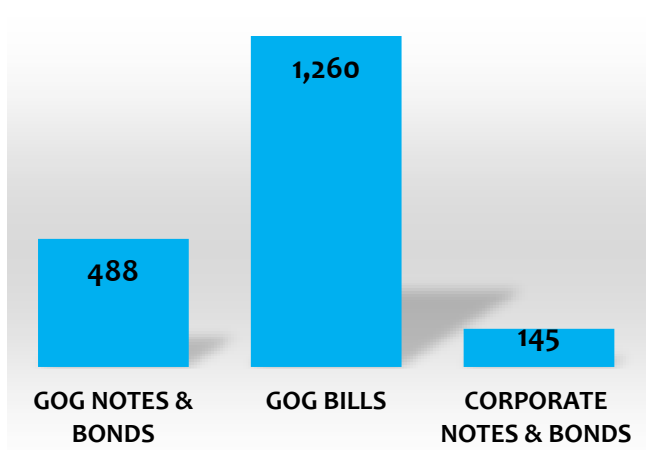

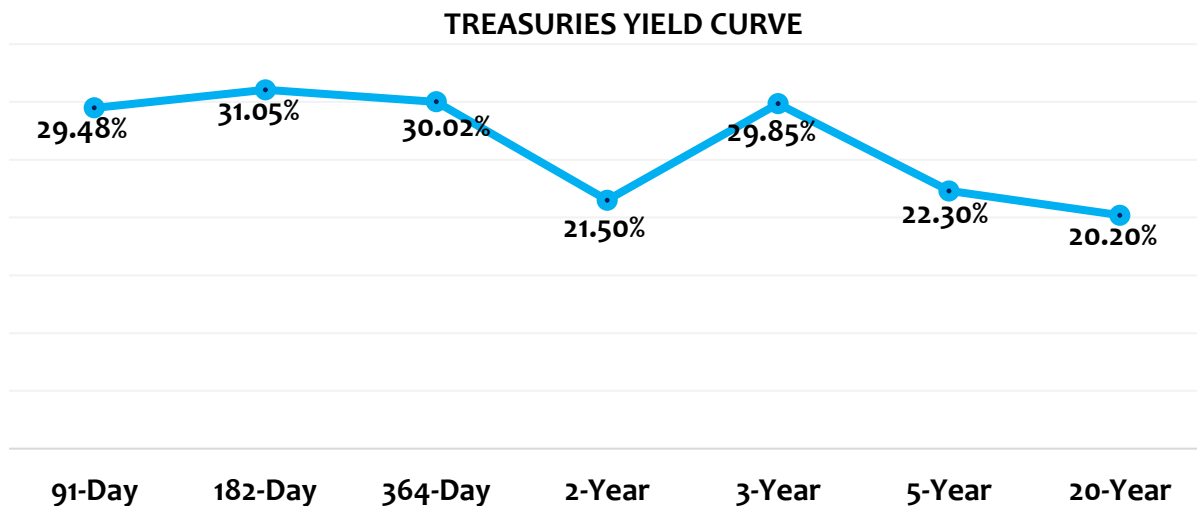
