

- Parliament to Hold Special Hearings on Extractive Industries' Impact on Jobs and National Development: Ghana's Majority Leader and Leader of Government Business, Mahama Ayariga, has announced that Parliament will hold special hearings on Ghana's extractive industries to assess their contribution to national development and job creation. The hearings will focus on assessing the effectiveness of local content laws in promoting local ownership and job creation. Ayariga emphasized the importance of job creation and accountability in sectors with high employment potential, such as mining, oil and gas, and agriculture. (Norvanreports)

Deputy Governor Matilda Asante Asiedu highlighted the country's progress over the past decade, focusing on three key priorities: strengthening instant payment infrastructure, expanding the eCedi pilot, and deepening trust through progressive regulation. Asiedu stressed that technology should empower, not exclude, and that every Ghanaian, regardless of location or circumstance, benefits from the opportunities created by digital innovation. 
